
HOW TO COLORING

Prep your tools: Use a dark pen or marker (black works great). Slip paper under if using markers to avoid bleed.



Follow the flow: Color inside the lines, which vary in width. Rotate the page for easy curves; stay steady but don't fret over perfection.

Reveal and enjoy: Finish , step back, and admire the hidden pic. Answers are in the back, but no peeking early—spoil the fun!
